This half term our learning journey will explore:

Farming and Food

Our Big Question is:

Where Does Food Come From?

Our Destination will be:

To prepare a Fair Trade meal for parents.

What we will be learning:

Science — To understand what plans need to survive, explain their life cycle and identify parts of plants and their functions. To conduct a fair test experiment on plant living conditions.

Computing — To explain how search engines work and use them to gather information.

Maths — Fractions and Mass and Capacity.

English — Writing a Narrative description based on the book "The Night Gardener".

Writing an explanation text about plants.

DT— To use cooking utensils to prepare a meal. To understand what makes a balanced diet and be able to evaluate and improve a meal design.

Geography — To explore Fair Trade alongside understanding food miles and the impact it has on the environment. Using atlases, maps, globes and digital mapping to locate different countries and climates where food is grown. Exploring our local produce and how it is grown in the UK.

Music — Year 3 will continue to learn how to play the drums.

RE — How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jews?

PE — Dance and Striking and Fielding
