Tipping the Scales- Think of a child's development as a scale. The way the scale ends up tipping is like the outcome of the child's development, so we want the scale to tip towards the positive side. Positive things like supportive relationships, lots of serve and return and 'positive stress' and calm and nurturing environments get loaded on one side. Here's an
