This half term our learning journey will be: Weather Watchers.

Our Big Question is: What is the weather like where we live?

Our Destination will be: To perform music and poems to parents.

What we will be learning:

Maths: Addition and Subtraction

Writing: Instructions - making a rain gauge. Weather poem. Whole Class weather diary

Science: Seasons, To name and describe the four seasons.

Computing: To use 'paint' to create a seasonal picture – exploring colours and shapes.

Design Technology: To design and make their own rain gauge for recycled material.

Geography: To keep a weather diary for a period of time.

Art: To explore colour mixing.

Music: To compose music based upon the weather/seasons. To explore how sounds can be made.

PSHE: Who is special to us?
