This half term our learning journey will explore:

Dinosaurs and Fossils

Our Big Question is:

What are fossils?

Our Destination will be:

To create a class directory of fossils and dinosaurs.

What we will be learning:

Science — To describe how fossils are formed. To investigate the differences between carnivores and herbivores (dinosaurs). To discover how dinosaurs adapted to the environment.

Computing — To use word processing to design and format the Mary Anning biography.

Maths — Adding, Subtracting, Multiplying and Dividing

English — Narrative – We will study the book "Mungo and the dinosaur island" by Timothy Knapman.

Biography - We will study biographoies and write one about Anning's life.

History — To understand where different dinosaurs and fossils fit on a timeline. To research about the life and work of Mary Anning.

Geography — To locate on a map the main fossil hunting areas of the UK.

Art — To create mod-roc dinosaurs. To use plaster of Paris to make fossils – linked to Anning discoveries.

RE — What is it like for someone to follow god?

PSHE — What keeps us safe?

PE — Multi-skills, Dance

MFL — French

Music — To create a piece of music varying in volume and tempo – dinosaur hunt, Drumming lessons
