This half term our learning journey will explore:

Master of Disaster

Our Big Question is:

Why do natural disasters happen?

Our Destination will be:

To create a non-fiction book about natural disasters .

What we will be learning:

Science — To understand that forces need contact between two objects. To investigate surface friction (e.g. caramel down a slope).

Computing — Online Safety.

Maths — Multiplying and Dividing, Statistics, Money, Measurement.

English — Diary Entry from a natural disaster. Poetry rhyming and onomatopoeia. Explanation text of how volcanos erupt.
