Attendance

It is important that these meetings are attended to ensure that we are providing the right support for your child to continue to attend school regularly. 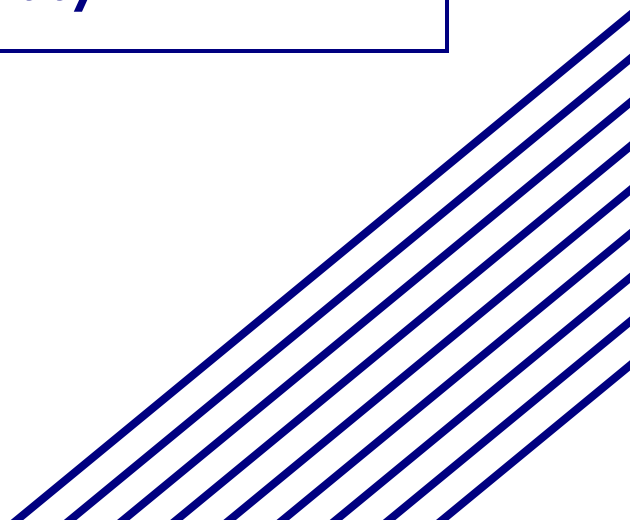


