The course is completely free, but the learning provider reserves the right to charge a drop out fee in the event a learner enrolls but then drops out without providing a reason.

**That said, the college will grant extensions if the learner has a reason as to why they won't be able to complete it within the allocated time**

Please note: under the college request you will need to attend a short zoom induction will need to be attended to ensure we get you successfully enrolled on-to the correct course
