The only criteria the learner must meet to be eligible, is the following...

- Aged 19 or over on or before 31st August 2021
- Have lived in the UK/EU for 3+ years

Not already on a Government funded course (Apprenticeship for example)























































The course is completely free, but the learning provider re-

serves the right to charge a drop out fee in the event a learner enrols but then drops out without providing a reason.



That said, the college will grant extensions if the learner

has a reason as to why they won't be able to complete it within the allocated time




